LEADERSHIP ANNE ARUNDEL FIRESIDE BREAKFAST TO FOCUS ON GLOBAL WARMING AND THE CHESAPEAKE BAY

ANNAPOLIS, MD (September 17, 2007) – Leadership Anne Arundel’s first Fireside Breakfast of the 2007-2008 program year will examine “Global Warming and the Chesapeake Bay: What Does the Future Hold for Us?” The breakfast will be held on Tuesday, October 23 from 7:30 to 9:30 a.m. in Room 224 of the Cade Center for Fine Arts, Anne Arundel Community College, 101 College Parkway in Arnold.

This breakfast will focus on the environmental and economic future of Anne Arundel County, particularly the effects of global warming on those living near the Chesapeake Bay. Featured speakers will include Dr. Steve Steele, Director of the Institute for the Future and Professor of Sociology at Anne Arundel Community College, who has been involved in futures work and applied sociology for three decades. The other speaker will be John Cleveland, founder and President of the Global Warming Action Alliance, whose mission is to educate the public about the realities of climate change and what people can do to reduce their carbon footprints.
