## Flagship 2019-2020 Program Application

### Tuition

The Flagship tuition rate is \$3,800 for corporations and \$3,050 for nonprofits (charitable, educational, fraternal, and governmental entities), individuals, and small businesses (no more than 5 employees). The tuition covers all program costs. Leadership Anne Arundel has scholarship funds available for individuals who demonstrate a need. The amount of scholarship funds provided to applicants is based upon the number of requests and available funds. LAA does not grant 100% scholarship. If you are interested in pursuing a scholarship, please indicate this in section II of the application. You also will need to complete an LAA Scholarship Form.

### Class Composition and Selection

Approximately 25 to 45 individuals are selected for this comprehensive, hands-on, multi-disciplinary study of Anne Arundel County. The class is composed of a cross-section of the Anne Arundel County community, representing out ethnically, socially, economically, and geographically diverse population. Each year's Flagship program has a different theme.

### Selection Criteria

- Sincere concern about the future of Anne Arundel County and a personal commitment to help shape that future
- Demonstrated commitment to leadership principles
- Ability and willingness to commit the time and energy necessary to complete the program (Leadership Anne Arundel adheres to a strict attendance policy.)
- Commitment to participate on one community project team
- Employer's full support (for applicants who represent organizations/businesses)

### Non-Discrimination

Leadership Anne Arundel does not discriminate against applicants or participants on the basis of race, religion, gender, national origin, sexual orientation, age or physical ability. All applications will be handled in the strictest confidence.
